NOTICE – COMPLAINANT MAY E-FILE AMENDED COMPLAINT

This case arises under the antidiscrimination provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act, as amended, 8 U.S.C. § 1324b.

On October 22, 2024, the Court issued an Order and Notice – Amended Complaint, through which it acknowledged Complainant’s unsuccessful attempts to submit a jurisdiction-related filing *Zajradhara v. Manbin Corp.*, 19 OCAHO no. 1553c, 2–3 (2024). In that Order, the Court afforded Complainant the opportunity to request leave to amend his Complaint to cure the jurisdictional deficiency. *Id.* at 3.

Based on Complainant’s difficulties providing filings through the mail (due to his location, among other issues), the Court will permit him to e-file a motion for leave to amend and a proposed amended complaint. *See* 28 C.F.R. § 68.28(a) (“[T]he Administrative Law Judge shall have all appropriate powers necessary to conduct fair and impartial hearings[.]”). Complainant must still comply with regulatory service requirements, including the Certificate of Service. E-filing is available at sctc.ocado@usdoj.gov. Complainant has until January 31, 2025, to submit a these filings.
