





About the same as No. 2... Just more with no voices heard. About a dozen marching from down the sidewalk to go into the Leflore County Courthouse to take voting exam. About 11:00 AM. About noon the group had lined up outside the Courthouse in twos as showing by Rev. D. L. Tucker, Pastor of Turner Chapel. Some of the group had spent only a short time in the Courthouse. They are marching out to the edge of the street where they crossed but block in the middle of the intersection and started marching, without anyone saying anything, toward the downtown section. Some more of the group as they marched by Samo The group had marched down to this corner. At the left Tucker had stopped it seemed with the idea of having a showup of the group on the corner. Shortly the police came up the men and one dog. Shows group being turned around the corner by dog and other police who came up. No one was touched by the dog here. Group being turned around the corner. Group being split up and sent in different directions. Between No. 10 and No. 11 photo Tucker left the group. More of the group being split.



	City police placed barricades at street at edge of Courthouse to stop autos from running in front of Courthouse. Negroes came by foot and walked by barricades. Whites said nothing to them just watched.
16 -	About same as No. 15
17 -	Police start to move whites who quietly gather to watch Negroes and cameramen.
18 -	Some of the whites had been moved from corner see photo no. 16
19 -	Looking South at street barricaded in front of Leflore Courthouse.
20 -	Looking north from Courthouse. Whites on lower right corner moved and others moved back up street. Chief CURTIS LARY with megaphone.
21 -	Negroes had gone into the courthouse to take vot exam. After they lined up in rows (two) to march as they did the day before they started but before they got to the street police Chief CURTIX LARY told them that he has asked them not to get into a large group, but to keep in small-so when they got to end of walk at street he divided them into small groups and sent them into different directions.
