- ⇒ Offender reintegration into society following incarceration is a public safety concern for law enforcement, first responders, safety officials, and our community.
- ⇒ More than 600,000 individuals return home to communities from incarceration annually. Without supports and resources in place, many of those individuals will reoffend following their release.
- ⇒ The transition from life in prison to life in the community can have profound implications for community safety.
- ⇒ A community strategy that includes a collaborative approach is necessary to promote successful offender reentry and reduce recidivism.
