INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

On or about February 27, 2018, within the special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of the United States, on a foreign vessel during a voyage having a scheduled departure from and arrival in the United States, the defendant,

BRIAN JAMES HOLLAND,

a national of the United States, did knowingly cause the victim, I.R., a national of the United States, to engage in a sexual act, to wit, the penetration of the genital opening by a finger, by the use of force against I.R.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2241(a) and 18 U.S.C. § 7.

**FORFEITURE**

1. The allegations contained in Count One are incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture, pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 2253.

2. Upon conviction of a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 2241, the defendant, BRIAN JAMES HOLLAND, shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253(a)(2), any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from such offense; and 18 U.S.C. § 2253(a)(3), any property real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of such offense or any property traceable to such property.

3. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or

- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;


the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), as incorporated by 18 U.S.C. § 2253(b).


