The Grand Jury charges that:

**COUNT 1**

On or about October 3, 2019, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **KAMAL AL JAWHARI**, knowing that he was an alien illegally and unlawfully in the United States, knowingly possessed a firearm and ammunition, to wit, a Winchester 12-gauge shotgun, Defender model, Serial # L1458240 and approximately 25 rounds of shotgun ammunition, and the firearm and ammunition were in and affecting commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(5)(A) and 924(a)(2).

**COUNT 2**

On or about October 3, 2019, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **KAMAL AL JAWHARI**, knowing that he was an alien illegally and unlawfully in the United States, knowingly possessed a firearm and ammunition, to wit, a Taurus Model 9 millimeter Slim pistol, Serial # TJY045158 and approximately 50 rounds of 9 millimeter ammunition, said firearm and ammunition were in and affecting commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(5)(A) and 924(a)(2).

**NOTICE OF FORFEITURE**

1. The allegations of Counts 1 and 2 are realleged and incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offenses alleged in Counts 1 and 2, the defendant, **KAMAL AL JAWHAIRI**, shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offenses, including but not limited to any firearm or ammunition described above.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:


- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
