INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

COUNT ONE

On or about March 19, 2020, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

MALCOLM JEROME STRAUGHTER,

knowing that he previously had been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, including:

1. Possession of a Short-Barreled Shotgun, on or about May 4, 2006;
2. Possession of Cocaine, on or about May 4, 2006;
3. Robbery with a Firearm, on or about July 3, 2006;

did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm, that is, a Jimenez pistol.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

FORFEITURE

1. The allegations contained in Count One are incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).

2. Upon conviction of a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g), the defendant shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), all firearms and ammunition involved in or used in the violation.


3. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, the following: a Jimenez 9mm pistol and 9mm ammunition.

4. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,


the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property under the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), as incorporated by 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).






