# <u>INFORMATION</u>

The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From in or about July 2018 to in or about November 2018, in Middlesex and Monmouth Counties, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

## DANIEL MCHUGH,

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with others to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 100 grams or more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B).

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.

### FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

As a result of committing the controlled substance offense charged on page 1 of this Information, the defendant,

### DANIEL MCHUGH,

shall forfeit to the United States of America, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853, any and all property constituting or derived from any proceeds obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said offense, and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to facilitate the commission of the offense alleged in this Information, including, but not limited to, \$3,800 in United States currency.

# <u>Substitute Assets Provision</u> (As To All Forfeiture Allegations)

If by any act or omission of the defendant any of the property subject to forfeiture described above:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

the United States shall be entitled, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above-described forfeitable property.
