The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the Acting United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

<u>COUNT ONE</u> (Receipt of Child Pornography)

From on or about January 1, 2017 through on or about November 20, 2019, in Hunterdon County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DANIEL MURPHY,

did knowingly receive and attempt to receive child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8), that had been mailed, and shipped and transported using a means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce, and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, and that was produced using materials that had been mailed, and shipped and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252A(a)(2)(A) and (b)(1).

<u>COUNT TWO</u> (Possession of Child Pornography)

From on or about January 1, 2017 through on or about November 20, 2019, in Hunterdon County, in the District of New Jersey, and elsewhere, the defendant,

DANIEL MURPHY,

did knowingly possess material containing at least three images of child pornography, as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 2256(8), that had been mailed, and shipped and transported using a means and facility of interstate and foreign commerce, and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, and that was produced using materials that had been mailed, and shipped and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(5) and (b)(2).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATIONS

1. The allegations set forth above are realleged and incorporated herein by reference.

2. Upon conviction of the violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A charged in this Information, defendant DANIEL MURPHY shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2253, all of his right, title, and interest in the following:

- a. Any visual depiction described in 18 U.S.C. §§ 2251, 2251A, 2252, 2252A, 2252B, or 2260, or any book, magazine, periodical, film, videotape, or other matter which contains any such visual depiction, which was produced, transported, mailed, shipped, or received in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Chapter 110;
- b. Any property, real or personal, constituting or traceable to gross profits or other proceeds obtained from the offenses set forth in this Information, and all property traceable to such property; and
- c. Any property, real or personal, used or intended to be used to commit or to promote the commission of the offenses set forth in this Information, and any property traceable to such property.
- 3. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, all of the

defendant's right, title, and interest in the following items:

- a. One HP Mini 311 laptop computer bearing serial number CNF00812J2;
- b. One DVD labeled "LS Series 1";
- c. Three cases of CDs;
- d. One HP Elitedesk 800 G3 SFF computer bearing serial number 2UA7361WT8;
- e. One Silver Stone desktop computer bearing serial number BN10450247; and

f. One Vensmile external hard drive.

SUBSTITUTE ASSETS PROVISION

4. If any of the above-described forfeitable property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty,

it is the intent of the United States, pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), as incorporated by 18 U.S.C. § 2253, to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the above-described forfeitable property.
