The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1 (Receipt of Firearm While Under Indictment or Information)

On or about October 29, 2021, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **JAVORIOUS SCOTT**, **a/k/a "JayDaYoungan,"** who was then under indictment for crimes punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to wit: Assault on a Pregnant Individual, in the District Court of Harris County, Texas, Case No. 1663457, and Possession of a Controlled Substance, Namely Oxycodone, Weighing Four (4) Grams but Less than Two Hundred (200) Grams, in the District Court of Harris County, Texas, Case No.1663615, did willfully

receive a firearm, to wit: a Ruger, Model Security-9, 9mm pistol, bearing serial Number 384-77996, said firearm having been shipped in and transported in interstate commerce, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(1)(D).

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

- 1. The allegation of Count 1 of this Indictment is incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.
- 2. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 1, the defendant, JAVORIOUS SCOTT, a/k/a "JayDaYoungan," shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 924(d)(1), and Title 28, United States Code, Section 2461(c), any firearm or ammunition involved in or used in the commission of said offense, including but not limited to the following:

Ruger, Model Security-9, 9mm pistol, bearing serial number 384-77996.

- 3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:
 - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
 - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person:
 - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court:
 - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
 - e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
