The United States Attorney charges that:

COUNT 1

A. AT ALL TIMES MATERIAL HEREIN:

1. Minor Victim was a juvenile female who was born in about June 2006 and resided in the Memphis, Tennessee area.
2. Minor Victim was reported to law enforcement authorities in the Memphis, Tennessee area as a missing juvenile in or about October 2020.
3. The defendant, **JEREMY TALBERT, a/k/a "J-Nasty" a/k/a "Jay Nastie"** (**TALBERT**) was an adult male born in 1995 who resided in the Memphis, Tennessee area.
4. On or about November 26, 2020, a posting titled "hey baby I'm here to satisfy you"

advertising a “50\$ head special” and “pornstar experience” with photographs of Minor Victim was posted to an online classified ad service commonly used to advertise sexual services in exchange for money.

5. On or about December 17, 2020, law enforcement officials recovered Minor Victim, who was with **TALBERT**, at a Motel 6, located at 4200 Old Gentilly Road, in New Orleans, Louisiana, within the Eastern District of Louisiana.

B. THE OFFENSE:

Beginning at a time unknown, but not later than in or around October 2020, and continuing until on or about December 17, 2020, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, and elsewhere, the defendant, **JEREMY TALBERT**, a/k/a “J-Nasty” a/k/a “Jay Nastie,” knowingly, in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce, recruited, enticed, transported, harbored, provided, obtained, and maintained, by any means, and attempted to recruit, entice, transport, harbor, provide, obtain, and maintain, Minor Victim, a person who had not attained the age of 18 years, having had a reasonable opportunity to observe Minor Victim, knowing and in reckless disregard of the fact that Minor Victim had not attained the age of 18 years and that Minor Victim would be caused to engage in a commercial sex act, as that term is defined by Title 18, United States Code, Section 1591(e)(3).

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 1591(a)(1), 1591(b)(2), 1594(a), and 2.

NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

1. The allegation of Count 1 of this Bill of Information is incorporated by reference as though set forth fully herein for the purpose of alleging forfeiture to the United States.

2. As a result of the offense alleged in Count 1, the defendant, **JEREMY TALBERT**,

a/k/a “J-Nasty” a/k/a “Jay Nastie,” shall forfeit to the United States pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 1594(d), any property, real or personal, involved in, used, or intended to be used to commit or to facilitate the commission of the offense, and any property traceable to such property; and any property, real or personal, constituting or derived from, any proceeds obtained, directly or indirectly, as a result of the offense, and any property traceable to such property.

3. If any of the above-described property, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:

- a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third person;
- c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
- e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
