INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:



COUNT ONE

On or about May 27, 2022, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

DARRIUS JAQUES GARRETT.

knowing he had been previously convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, including:

- 1. Possession of more than 20 grams of Cannabis, on or about August 3, 2009;
- 2. Attempted Burglary of a Dwelling, on or about May 12, 2010;
- 3. Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer, on or about May 12, 2010;
- 4. Grand Theft Third Degree of \$10,000 or more, on or about May 12, 2010;
- 5. Possession of Oxycodone, on or about December 9, 2021, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Glock pistol and .22 caliber ammunition.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

COUNT TWO

On or about June 1, 2022, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant,

DARRIUS JAQUES GARRETT,

knowing he had been previously convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, including:

- 1. Possession of more than 20 grams of Cannabis, on or about August 3, 2009;
- 2. Attempted Burglary of a Dwelling, on or about May 12, 2010;
- 3. Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer, on or about May 12, 2010;
- 4. Grand Theft Third Degree over \$10,000, on or about May 12, 2010;
- 5. Possession of Oxycodone, on or about December 9, 2021, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, a firearm and ammunition, that is, a Glock pistol and .22 caliber ammunition.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(a)(2).

FORFEITURE

- 1. The allegations contained in Counts One and Two are incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).
- 2. Upon conviction of a violation of 18 U.S.C. § 922(g), the defendant shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 924(d) and 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c), all firearms and ammunition involved in or used in the violation.

- 3. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, the following: a Glock pistol, serial number AEEU757, and .22 caliber ammunition, all of which was seized on June 1, 2022.
- 4. If any of the property described above, as a result of any act or omission of the defendant:
 - a. cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
 - b. has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
 - c. has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the court;
 - d. has been substantially diminished in value; or
 - e. has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty,

the United States shall be entitled to forfeiture of substitute property under the provisions of 21 U.S.C. § 853(p), as incorporated by 28 U.S.C. § 2461(c).
