

## **Instructor Qualifications for Project SAFE – 4 Day Training**

### **Lead Instructor 1**

- Have completed a 32-hour basic or foundational Forensic Interviewing training
- Have completed a minimum of 32 hours of advanced Forensic Interviewing training(s)
- Have conducted over 250 Forensic interviews or investigations of vulnerable persons within the last 5 years
- Have a minimum of 5 years' experience conducting Forensic Interviews or investigations involving victimization, abuse (physical, sexual, financial, etc.) or neglect against vulnerable persons
- Have conducted at least 5 trainings on forensic interviewing or MDT investigations on abuse and neglect against vulnerable persons within the last 2 years

### **Lead Instructor 2**

- Have completed a 32-hour basic or foundational Forensic Interviewing training
- Have experience conducting trainings involving abuse and neglect of older adults
- Have a minimum of 5 years' experience conducting forensic interviews, investigations or participating in multi-disciplinary teams involving victimization, abuse (physical, sexual, financial, etc.) or neglect of older adults

### **Or**

- Have a minimum of 5 years' experience prosecuting, investigating, forensically interviewing, or participating in joint investigations involving crimes against older adults

## **Instructor Qualifications for Project SAFE – 4 Day Training**

### **Practicum Instructors (minimum of 2)**

- Have completed a 32-hour basic or foundational Forensic Interviewing training
- Have completed a minimum of 32 hours of advanced Forensic Interviewing training(s)
- Have conducted over 250 Forensic interviews or investigations of vulnerable persons within the last 5 years
- Have a minimum of 5 years' experience conducting forensic interviews, investigations or participating in multi-disciplinary teams involving victimization, abuse (physical, sexual, financial, etc.) or neglect of vulnerable persons

### **Or**

- Have a minimum of 5 years' experience prosecuting, investigating, forensically interviewing, or participating in joint investigations involving crimes against vulnerable persons
