      The proposed settlement resolves the United States' claims under
Section 107 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, 42 U.S.C. 9607, against Mazza & Sons, Inc., for
recovery of past response costs incurred at the Frankfort Asbestos
Superfund Site. The Site is located at 3720 Southside Road (Old New
York State 5S), approximately one mile northwest of the Town of
Frankfort, in Herkimer County, New York. Under the proposed Consent Decree, Mazza & Sons, Inc. will pay $250,000 in past response costs to resolve the United States' claims.
     The publication of this notice opens a period for public comment on
