## **EOIR to Open West Los Angeles Immigration Court Los Angeles – Olive Street Immigration Court to Close**

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) today announced that the West Los Angeles Immigration Court will open on May 6, 2024, and the Los Angeles – Olive Street Immigration Court will close at the close of business on April 17, 2024.

From April 18 through April 29, the Santa Ana Immigration Court will serve as the alternate filing location for cases assigned to the Los Angeles – Olive Street Immigration Court and for cases assigned to the West Los Angeles Immigration Court. The West Los Angeles Immigration Court will begin accepting phone calls and filings on April 30, 2024.

Cases currently assigned to the Los Angeles – Olive Street Immigration Court will transfer to one of the following Los Angeles Immigration Courts: West Los Angeles, North Los Angeles, or Van Nuys Boulevard. EOIR will provide official advance notice to all parties whose cases are reassigned.
