For all inactive pending cases, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 6,120 days (approximately  $16\frac{1}{2}$  years) and the median length of time is 4,242 days (approximately  $11\frac{1}{2}$  years). At Immigration Court, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 5,864 days (approximately 16 years) and the median length of time is 4,070 days (over 11 years). At the Board of Immigration Appeals, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 10,647 days (approximately 29 years) and the median length of time is 12,588 days (approximately 34 years).
