For all inactive pending cases, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 5,657 days (approximately 15½ years) and the median length of time is 3,899 days (over 10 years).

At Immigration Court, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 5,406 days (approximately 15 years) and the median length of time is 3,708 days (over 10 years).

At the Board of Immigration Appeals, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 10,549 days (approximately 29 years) and the median length of time is 12,497 days (approximately 34 years).
