ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF
REFERRAL TO SETTLEMENT OFFICER PROGRAM

On April 24, 2025, the Court granted the parties’ Joint Consent to Enter Settlement Officer Program and Joint Motion to Stay Deadlines. United States v. Maya del Sol, LLC, 20 OCAHO no. 1607c (2025).¹ The Court referred the parties to the program for an initial period of 60 days, to conclude on June 20, 2025, but noted that “[s]hould the parties feel an extension of the referral period would be beneficial, they may seek an extension of up to 30 days by notifying the settlement officer, who will relay the request to the undersigned.” Id. at 3–4.

On June 16, 2025, the settlement officer informed the undersigned that the parties were negotiating in good faith and have made progress towards a settlement. The officer also noted that while the parties have yet to reach an agreement, they jointly requested a 30-day extension of the referral period to allow them time to continue negotiating.
