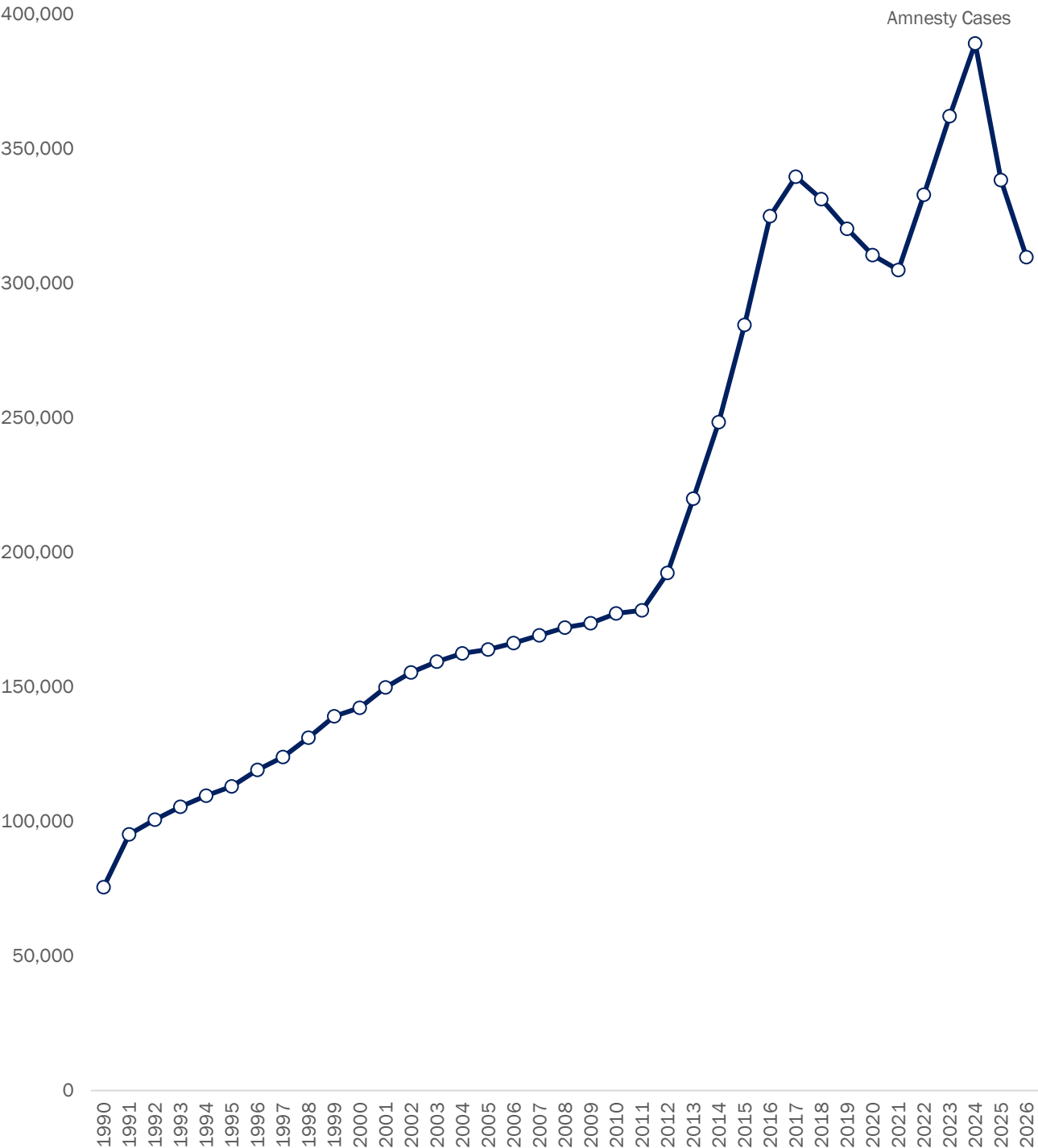

For all amnesty cases, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 6,929 days (approximately 19 years) and the median length of time is 5,111 days (approximately 14 years).

At Immigration Court, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 6,657 days (approximately 18 years) and the median length of time is 4,834 days (approximately 13 years).

At the Board of Immigration Appeals, the average length of time a case has been administratively closed is 11,050 days (approximately 30 years) and the median length of time is 12,593 days (approximately 35½ years).
