On March 25, 2025, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss, arguing the Complaint is time-barred. Complainant opposed this Motion, and Respondent provided a Reply filing.

After carefully reviewing parties' filings, the Court deemed it prudent to invite amicus briefing. The invitation was posted on the EOIR website, and garnered one brief.¹
