Pursuant to 28 C.F.R. § 68.14(a), the Court may dismiss a complaint through either a consent judgment or through the parties' notification of their settlement and request for dismissal. With settlement agreements, the dismissal "shall be subject to the approval of the Administrative Law Judge, who may require the filing of the settlement agreement." Further, the

Court may, in their discretion, conduct a hearing to determine the fairness of the agreement. 28 C.F.R. § 68.14(c).

In light of Complainant's pro se status, the Court exercises its discretion and directs that the parties shall, within 21 days of the issuance of this order, submit a copy of the settlement agreement for review by the Court. Upon a review of the agreement, the Court will thereafter dismiss this matter pursuant to 28 C.F.R. § 68.14(a).
