1. DHS Portal Single Sign-On for ICE

EOIR has federated with the DHS ICE component, so ICE authorized users no longer need to register with EOIR to obtain a username and password to use the DHS Portal.

Before attempting to login to the DHS Portal for the first time, authorized ICE users must contact their IT Service Desk to be added to the active group of users. Once added, ICE authorized users can access the DHS Portal using single sign-on (i.e., users will not be prompted for credentials) via the ICE Single Sign-On button.

All other authorized DHS users must register with EOIR to access the DHS Portal. They will then use their username and password to login to the portal via the Registered User (Acct Name/Password) button. If you are an authorized DHS user that has not registered to use the DHS Portal, please visit EOIR's [13 page](#) to learn more about the process and to register.

Please note, EOIR is working with DHS to reach a federation agreement, so authorized users in other DHS components can access the DHS Portal using single sign-on.

DHS Portal Access Information

At this point in time, to access EOIR's DHS Portal, authorized users are broken into two groups.

ICE Users

Before attempting to login to the DHS Portal for the first time, authorized ICE users must contact their IT Service Desk to be added to the active group of users. Once added, ICE authorized users can access the DHS portal using single sign-on (i.e., users will not be prompted for credentials) via the ICE Single Sign-On button.

All Other DHS Users

All other authorized DHS users must register with EOIR to access the DHS Portal. They will then use their username and password to login to the portal via the Registered User (User ID/Password) button. If you are an authorized DHS user that has not registered to use the DHS Portal, please visit EOIR's 13 page (<https://www.justice.gov/eoir/information-immigration-info>) to learn more about the process and to register.

Please note, EOIR is working with DHS to reach a federation agreement with the components that fall under this group, so that those authorized users can access the DHS Portal using single sign-on (i.e., users will not be prompted for credentials).

2. Proof of Filing for Electronically Filed Images

EOIR provides proof of filing for electronically filed documents in the form of a watermark with the date, time, and EOIR base city listed. Previously, this proof of filing was limited to PDF files. Now images electronically filed as .jpeg by DHs Users will also have a watermark containing the proof of filing.
