STANDING ORDER RELATING TO TELEPHONIC APPEARANCES AT INDIVIDUAL HEARINGS BEFORE IMMIGRATION JUDGE JENNIFER I. GAZ

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that parties scheduled to appear for an individual hearing before Immigration Judge Jennifer I. Gaz at the Eloy Immigration Court may appear telephonically, without the need to file a motion for telephonic appearance.

It is counsel's responsibility to provide a telephone number to the court staff where they can be reached for the hearing and to be available for the court's call. If the Court is unable to reach counsel by telephone for the hearing, counsel will thereafter be required to appear in-person at any rescheduled hearing. For the duration of this order parties may appear by cell phone or land line, however the parties shall make reasonable efforts to avoid background noise or counsel will thereafter be required to appear in-person at any rescheduled hearing. The parties must discuss any stipulations or agreements prior to the individual hearing.

This order shall remain in effect until rescinded by the court.
