1. Hearing Location Street Address Information displayed in “New Case Details”

Hearing location address is now available in the “New Case Details” screen in the DHS Portal. When entering information for a new case, DHS Users are now provided with the hearing location street address when selecting the hearing location from the pull down menu. A pop-up box with the street address appears when the user hovers the pointer over a hearing location in the pull down menu. This feature will make it easier to identify the correct hearing location to select when entering a new case.

2. Case Details no longer displayed when case is completed

Users no longer have the ability to view the details for a case that has been completed. When selecting the “view case details” icon, a pop-up message will appear indicating, “This case is completed. Details are not available. Please contact the immigration court at which you are filing, for more information.”

Schedule a New Case

Enter an Alien Number to search for existing cases. Please add a leading zero to the front of an 8-digit A-Number (e.g., 012-345-678 or 012345678). For Lead, Rider, or Family cases, please enter Lead Alien Number first.
Please schedule a Lead case before scheduling a Rider or Family case.

3. Decision description is shown instead of decision code

A decision reason will be displayed if the case has been completed rather than the decision code, as previously displayed. Users are no longer required to interpret the code.




Figure 3: Textual decision reason is displayed for a completed case

4. Message indicating eROP is ready to download

After selecting to download an eROP, the user must wait until the system has finished processing the request to download the eROP contents. With this enhancement, a message indicating that the eROP download is ready, will appear when the user hovers the pointer over the Download Icon. The user also will receive instant notification that the download is ready, wherever the user is, within the application.

5. List of eROP documents is now sorted by filed date

In the Alien eROP/Accepted Documents screens, the documents listed are sorted by Filed Date rather than added to eROP date.
