EOIR to Close Louisville Immigration Court

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Executive Office for Immigration Review today announced it will permanently close the Louisville Immigration Court after close of business on July 30, 2021, and establish Louisville as a hearing location under the administrative control of the Memphis Immigration Court.

In August 2019, EOIR suspended operations at the leased location where the Louisville Immigration Court was previously housed, pursuant to the U.S. General Services Administration's (GSA) recommendation, due to the physical conditions of the building in which the Court was located. The GSA subsequently terminated the lease on Dec. 6, 2019.

All pleadings and other correspondence for cases assigned to this hearing location should be filed at the <u>Memphis Immigration Court</u>.
