¹ Dedicated Docket cases are marked with a Dedicated Docket case identifier and are at an established Dedicated Docket hearing location. Removal, deportation, exclusion, asylum-only, and withholding-only cases. In April 2022, DHS determined that Cubans, Venezuelans, and Nicaraguans did not meet the requirements for placement on the dedicated docket. Most Cubans, Venezuelans, and Nicaraguans were subsequently placed on a non-detained docket.

² Cases in this category include those identified as Dedicated Docket cases by DHS and are currently being heard at a Dedicated Docket hearing location. Case types include removal, deportation, exclusion, asylum-only, and withholding-only.

³ The categories of “Pending” and “Completions” do not include all possible actions. Certain seldom used action types are not included here, thus the sum of pending cases and initial case completions does not equal the total receipts.
