EOIR to Open Santa Ana Immigration Court

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR) today announced it will open a new immigration court in Santa Ana, California, on Nov. 29, 2021, expanding the agency’s presence in Southern California.

Once fully staffed, the Santa Ana Immigration Court will include 22 Immigration Judges. At the time of opening, three immigration judges will hear cases transferred from the Los Angeles – Olive Street Immigration Court. EOIR has sent official notification of change of hearing location to some affected parties and will continue to provide notices to those whose hearing location has changed.

The court is centrally located in Orange County near the Costa Mesa Freeway (SR-55) Dyer Road exit. Contact information for the new immigration court is as follows:
