



3. Respondent further acknowledges that if this matter were to proceed to a hearing, there would be a substantial likelihood that OGC would prevail on the merits, and that he would be unable to rebut the presumption of under 8 C.F.R. § 3.103(b)(2)(i) - (iii) that reciprocal (i.e., identical) discipline should be imposed.

4. Respondent affirms that he has not engaged in the practice of law in any form, including the practice of immigration law, since at least June 25, 2001, the effective date of his suspension by the Supreme Court of Illinois.

5. To date, Respondent has not been reinstated to practice law in Illinois.

6. Therefore, Respondent consents to a one (1) year suspension before the Immigration Courts, Board of Immigration Appeals ("Board"), and Immigration and Naturalization Service ("Service"), effective nunc pro tunc to June 25, 2001. By this consent, Respondent acknowledges that he will not be eligible for reinstatement pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 3.107(a), unless and until he is readmitted to practice law in Illinois.


7. Once Respondent is readmitted to practice law in Illinois, he may file a notice to the Board for its immediate consideration, together with sufficient evidence of such readmission, requesting that he be reinstated to practice before the Immigration Courts, Board, and Service, pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 3.107(a). If Respondent files such notice with the requisite evidence of readmission and OGC verifies that Respondent has, in fact, been readmitted to the practice of

law in Illinois, OGC will file a notice of non-opposition.

By consent, it is ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Respondent shall be suspended from practice before the Board, Immigration Courts, and Service, for one (1) year, nunc pro tunc to March 22, 2001, as stayed by the Supreme Court of Illinois on April 23, 2001 until June 25, 2001, and until such further order of the Board on application for reinstatement pursuant to 8 C.F.R. § 3.107(a).


