The respondent, who has been suspended from practice before the Board, Immigration Courts, and the Department of Homeland Security (the "DHS") for 60 days, has sought reinstatement to practice. His request for reinstatement to practice will be granted.


On June 12, 2014, the final order of discipline was entered against the respondent. This resulted from the respondent's suspension from the practice of law by the Supreme Court of California. The respondent's suspension was deemed to have commenced on June 3, 2014, the date of our immediate suspension order.

The respondent requests to be reinstated to practice before the Board, the Immigration Courts, and the DHS. *See* 8 C.F.R. § 1003.107. The EOIR Disciplinary Counsel does not oppose the motion, observing that he has completed the period of suspension, and meets the definition of attorney at 8 C.F.R. § 1101.1(f). The respondent will be reinstated to practice.

ORDER: The respondent is reinstated to practice before the Board, the Immigration Courts, and the DHS, as of the date of this order.

FURTHER ORDER: Because the respondent has been reinstated, public notices regarding the respondent's suspension should reflect this reinstatement.

FURTHER ORDER: If the respondent wishes to represent a party before the DHS or Board, he must file a Notice of Appearance (Form G-28 or Form EOIR-27), including any case in which he was formerly counsel, prior to his suspension.
