<u>ORDER</u>

Upon consideration of the motion for alternative victim notification filed by the government, the Court finds that (1) the "multiple crime victims" provision set forth in 18 U.S.C. § 371(d)(2) applies to this case; (2) that, due to the number of victims, it is impractical for the government and the Court to identify and notify direct and proximate victims of the charged offenses on an individual basis without unduly complicating or prolonging the proceedings; (3) the basis of notification set forth in the government's motion constitutes a "reasonable procedure" for giving effect to the provisions of the Crime Victims' Rights Act.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The government is authorized to comply with the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 3771(a)(2) in this case by providing notice of upcoming court proceedings as followed:

- Internet. The United States Attorney's Office will designate a specific area on its website (http://www.justice.gov/usao-edmi) to provide public information regarding this case;
- Telephone. The government will provide updates on a voice recorded message accessed by a toll-free telephone number dedicated to this case; and
- 3. **Newspaper Publication**. The government will issue a press release and publish a legal notice in the Detroit Free Press and the Detroit News in an effort to reach any and all victims not notified by other means directing them to access the website for more information.
