FY 2019 Strategy:

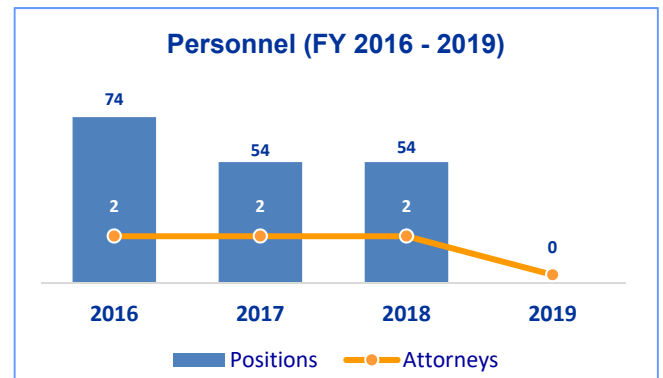
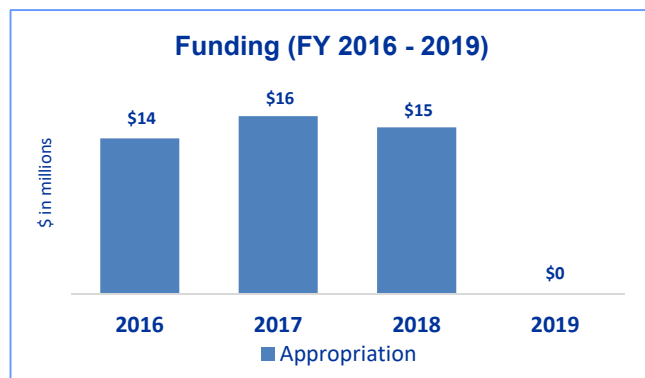
