**ATTACHMENT A**

From in or about November 2016 to in or about November 2018, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, defendant

PAUL SALCEDO,

did knowingly and intentionally conspire and agree with each other and with others, known and unknown, to distribute and possess with intent to distribute 280 grams or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base, a Schedule II controlled substance; a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, a Schedule II controlled substance; 1 kilogram or more of a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of heroin, a Schedule I controlled substance; and a mixture or substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl, a Schedule II controlled substance, contrary to Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A), and in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 846.
