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

- You expressly agree that no lien shall attach to any real property, buildings, structures or other improvements owned by or in the custody of Borg-Warner, either on your behalf or on behalf of your subcontractors, mechanics, journeymen, laborers, materialmen, or persons performing labor or furnishing materials and machinery pursuant to Borg-Warner Purchase Orders as may be issued to you. You do hereby expressly waive all rights to any such liens under the laws of the State in which you are performing the services to Borg-Warner for and on behalf of yourself and all others performing and/or furnishing such labor and materials as mentioned above in any form or manner whatsoever. You further agree to indemnify and hold Borg-Warner harmless from any costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, losses or damages resulting from the filling of any liens by yourself, your subcontractors or any other persons furnishing labor or materials pursuant to any Borg-Warner Purchase Order issued to you.
- Upon request by Borg-Warner, you agree to notify Borg-Warner, in writing, of the names of any subcontractors you have used, you are using, or that you propose to use, for any part of the services covered by Borg-Warner Purchase Orders. You further agree not to employ any such subcontractor which Borg-Warner may object to for any reason whatsoever.

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EXHIBIT B CONTRACTOR'S SAFETY AGREEMENT

The passage of the Federal Construction Safety Act in 1969 and the Occupational Safety and Health Act in 1970 provides for on the job safety and health protection for all employees. Borg-Warner Chemicals recognizes the importance of job enrironment hazard control and advises all contractors that job hazards not covered in the Code of Federal Regulations Title 29, Chapter XVII, Part 1926 Construction Regulations, but covered by Part 1910 OSHA Standards is considered as applying to centractors by OSHA compliance officers.

OSHA holds the employer responsible for permitting their employees to be exposed to job hazards. Borg-Warner Chemicals expects the contractor and subcontractors, if any, to assume all obligations prescribed as employer obligations under OSHA Regulations. The contractor(s) shall adhere to all applicable Federal, State and/or Local statutes and codes concerned with safety and health requirements. Borg-Warner Chemicals is to be indemnified if any contractor(s) actions or omissions cause a loss, penalty, or other liability to be incurred.

It is Borg-Warner Chemicals intention to control recognized job hazards and by so doing prevent injuries to employees. The exercise of such control shall not excuse the contractor(s) of total responsibility for the safety of his (their) workmen. The prime contractor has the entire responsibility for hazard control covering the work under the contract (including subcontractors, if any). It is the responsibility of the contractor to provide his employees with a safe working environment and, at the same time, not endanger others that may enter the work area. It is the responsibility of the contractor to enforce all safety requirements and provide the equipment, etc. required to assure a safe working environment. These responsibilities cannot be delegated or contracted away.

When the contract requires working directly with plant personnel, plant safety rules and procedures established by Borg-Warner Chemicals to assure a safe working environment must also be adhered to. When reasonably possible separate and/or isolated work areas will be established.

Due to the special nature of many of our operations the following instructions are to be followed in addition to the requirements of the applicable Local, State and/or Federal requirements:

Underground Service Hazards

To assure that no underground service such as power cables, sewers, or fire lines, etc., are in the area the Borg-Warner Chemicals Project Engineer or his assignee must approve, before starting, any excavating, driving of objects into the ground or through floors, or the hauling or dumping of heavy loads.

Hand, excavation must be used to locate underground service in the area before proceeding with mechanical means. Excavation safety is the responsibility of the contractor(s).

- a. Clearance from the Borg-Warner Chemicals Project Engineer or his assignee must be obtained before shutting off any utility or service.
- b. PERMISSION FROM THE BORG-WARNER CHEMICALS PROJECT ENGINEER OR HIS ASSIGNEE MUST BE OBTAINED IN WRITING BEFORE SHUTTING OFF OR PLACING OUT OF SERVICE ANY FIRE PROTECTIVE DEVICE OR SERVICE. NO FIRE HYDRANT, POST INDICATOR VALVE, OR OTHER PORTION OF THE PLANT FIRE SYSTEM SHALL BE USED OR OPERATED BY CONTRACT OR CONSTRUCTION WORKERS.

Leaving Job Before Completion

When it is necessary within an existing Borg-Warner Chemicals unit to leave a job before completion, all material, rigging, boards, loose nails, and other debris must be carefully removed from the floor. There shall be no materials or equipment left overhead or on the roof unless it is secured in place. Adequate barricades and warnings must be erected at all openings, excavations and obstructions. Any equipment left on the site will be adequately secured.

GBE 44727 CONFIDENTIAL Completion of Job

The Contractor when working within existing Borg-Warner Chemicals units shall not allow waste material or rubbish to accumulate in or about the premises, but shall remove the same promptly, as the Project Engineer may direct. After the completion of the work, the Contractor shall thoroughly remove all rubbish from and about the work and shall promptly remove all equipment, tools, scaffolding and surplus materials, and shall leave the work area clean and ready for use. In case of failure of the Contractor to so remove such rubbish, equipment, tools, scaffolding and surplus materials Borg-Warner Chemicals may remove same at the Contractor's expense.

Restrictions

No contract employee will be allowed entry into a production area without a pass. Passes for contract workers will be provided by a Borg-Warner Chemicals Project Engineer or where applicable, the Maintenance Supervisor, and will limit the workers presence to a specific work area.

Contractor is not to move a piece of Borg-Warner Chemicals equipment, such as a machine, crane, tractor or fork truck. The Borg-Warner Chemicals foreman must be requested to have such equipment moved.

Trucks or other vehicles being operated on Borg-Warner Chemicals premises must be operated safely at all times, and stored in authorized places as directed by the Borg-Warner Chemicals Project Engineer.

Vehicles inside the perimeter fence shall not block roads, fire lanes, or pedestrian walkways at any time. Park only on roads or assigned areas.

Smoking is permitted in designated areas only, as assigned. Smoking in construction areas within existing Borg-Warner Chemicals units will be restricted to designated sub-areas or to where smoke rooms are provided.

IN THE EVENT OF FIRE, WORKERS WILL IMMEDIATELY SHUT OFF ELECTRIC MOTORS ENGINES AND SPARKING TOOLS AND REPORT TO THEIR FOREMAN OR SUPERVISOR FOR EVACUATION INSTRUCTIONS. DRILLS WILL BE OBSERVED BY ALL WORKERS BY CARRYING OUT LOCAL PLANT PROCEDURES FOR AN ACTUAL FIRE ALARM.

Insurance Coverage

Proof of satisfactory insurance coverage, including liability and workman's compensation must be furnished by the Contractor and accepted by the Purchasing Department before any work is started.

The above SAFETY AGREEMENT has been read and their conditions are hereby accepted by the undersigned on behalf of himself (or itself) and his (or its) employees, agents and subcontractors and subcontractors and subcontractors of this safety agreement and agrees that he (or its) employees, agents, and subcontractors of this SAFETY AGREEMENT and agrees that he (or it) will conform and will have all employees, agents and subcontractors conform with this SAFETY AGREEMENT at all times while on the premises controlled by Borg-Warner Chemicals, it being understood that any person not conforming with this SAFETY AGREEMENT shall not be permitted to perform services on such premises.

It is also understood by the undersigned that compliance with this SAFETY AGREEMENT is a continuing requirement and that in consideration of the undersigned accepting any contract to be performed on Borg-Warner Chemicals premises, the acceptance and compliance with these conditions shall be continued for the duration of the Project.

EXHIBIT B

CONTRACTORS' SAFETY AGREEMENT

It is Borg-Warner Chemicals' intent to employ only contractors and service personnel (hereafter referred to as "Contractors") who will manage themselves, their employees, subcontractors and operations in such a manner as to prevent harm to persons or property.

The signature of the Contractor at the end of this Agreement indicates the agreement of the Contractor to accept full responsibility for himself*, his employees and subcontractors to provide the required services in such a manner as to eliminate the causes of personal injuries and accidents. In the pursuance of his services, the Contractor agrees to comply with all applicable government statutes and regulations, to adhere to the general rules and regulations listed below, or any rule or regulation brought to the Contractor's attention by a Borg-Warner Chemicals' representative at the work site.

For simplicity, the use of any personal pronoun or adjective in this document implying a particular gender is specifically defined to include all genders.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Contractor will designate one person to be responsible for assuring 1. that all obligations under this Agreement are carried out.
- The Contractor will provide all tools, equipment and supplies necessary to perform the work involved. However, all such stores must be in compliance with Borg-Warner Chemicals' (BWC) standards as explained by 2. the BWC site representative.
- 3. Before any work can begin:
 - A signed copy each of this Agreement and Insurance Agreement (Exhibit A) must be in the hands of BWC.
 - A BWC site representative must conduct a safety orientation and issue written permission specific to the work involved. All workers must be issued passes for overt display.
- Admittance and discharge from the plant will be through a route specified by the BWC site representative and upon show of the pass previously mentioned.

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- The following activities are strictly prohibited except as specifically 5. authorized by the BWC site representative.
 - Any entrance, movement, operation or parking of motor vehicles

Smoking

Excavation, either manual or power-driven

Connections, alterations or interruption to any site facilities, services or utilities

- The removal or discharge of chemically contaminated solid or liquid waste
- Housekeeping at the work site must be maintained in accordance with 6. BWC's standards at all times; including when the job is left in an uncompleted state.
- In the event of fire or other hazard identified by a sounding alarm, 7. employees must immediately shut down all drivers and sparking equipment and report to a location designated by the BWC site representative.
- The Contractor will notify the BWC site representative immediately of any accident or injury occurring at the site and will forthwith prepare a 8. complete report describing the accident or injury.
- 9. Failure to comply with the above rules and regulations and others explained by the BWC site representative shall constitute cause for immediate termination without cost to Borg-Wanrer, Chemicals.
