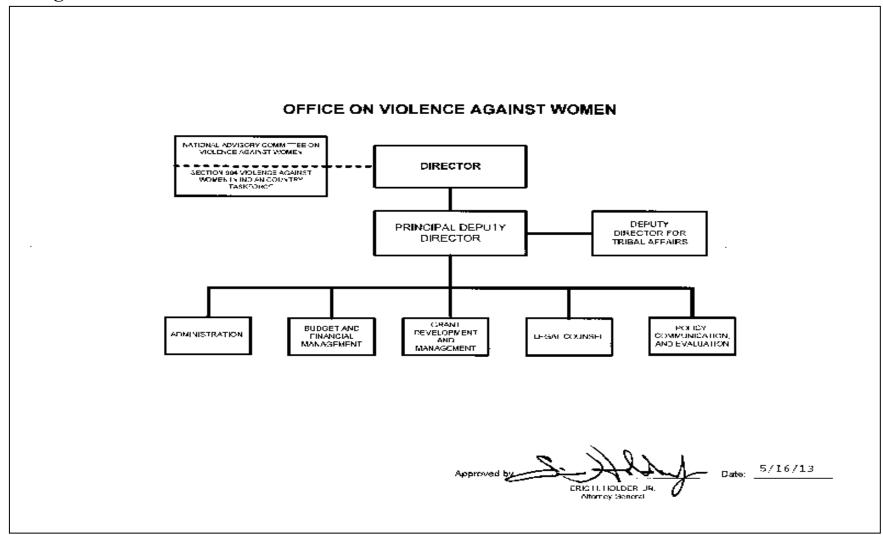
A: Organizational Chart
