Dear Commissioners:

I want to express my appreciation for your continued commitment to the work of the Commission, both through your participation in the working groups, strong engagement in the telephone hearings, and now as we review the Commission report draft chapters.

As you know, the Commission must produce a report for the Attorney General and the President. To that end, the Working Groups and staff have been hard at work writing portions of that report. You have received the first set of five chapters with instructions on completing your review in the email thread below. We are hoping to receive those comments today or over the weekend, if possible.

Today I am including the next second set of chapters for your review, including Social Problems Impacting Public Safety, Rural and Tribal Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice System Personnel Intersection, and Juvenile Justice and Youth Crime for your initial review.

As you read, please keep in mind that these chapters are an early draft. I would ask that you read these documents with an eye for content and substance to ensure there are no gaps in the material covered, that recommendations are included, and that important topics aren't omitted. Some editing steps (grammar and style checks, fact and citation checks and layout editing) have not been completed so you will not have to make those types of edits.

Understanding that you have many competing demands on your time, I am asking for comments to be provided by COB Thursday, June 4. As you conduct your review, please use the track changes and comments functions (both are accessible from the Review tab in MS Word) so that the Commission staff can incorporate them. When you have finished, you can send your documents to [LECommission@usdoj.gov](mailto:LECommission@usdoj.gov).

As a reminder, you will receive the remaining chapters on June 5.
