

Executive Grant of Clemency

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.**, Reg. No. 05441-104, was convicted, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida on a second superseding indictment (Docket No. 13-10034-CR-MARTINEZ) of violations of Sections 982(a), 1014, 1344, 1512(c)(2), Title 18, and Section 2461(c), Title 28, United States Code, for which a total sentence of 480 months' imprisonment, five years' supervised release, \$179,076,941.89 restitution, a \$700 special assessment, and a forfeiture of money and property totaling between \$311,555,776 and \$311,655,776 was imposed on February 22, 2016, as amended on February 25, 2016, and June 23, 2016; and

WHEREAS the said **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.** had been confined continuously since his arrest on June 18, 2014, pursuant to an arrest warrant and indictment filed in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, and he is presently incarcerated at the Federal Correctional Institution—Coleman Medium in Sumterville, Florida; and

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that the ends of justice do not require the said **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.** to remain confined until his currently projected release date of August 14, 2048, and the safety of the community will not be compromised if he is released;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that I, **DONALD J. TRUMP**, President of the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, divers other good and sufficient reasons me thereunto moving, do hereby grant clemency to the said **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.**: I commute the prison sentence imposed upon the said **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.** to time served. I leave intact and in effect the remaining unpaid balances, if any, of the \$179,076,941.89 restitution obligation, \$700 special assessment, and the entirety of the forfeiture obligation. I also leave intact and in effect the five-year term of supervised release with all its conditions, and all other components of the sentence.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower, the Acting Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to deliver to the Bureau of Prisons, to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, and to the said **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.** a certified copy of this document as evidence of my action in order to carry into effect the terms of this grant.

I **ALSO DIRECT** the Bureau of Prisons, upon receipt of this warrant, to effect the immediate release of the said **FRED DAVIS CLARK, JR.** with all possible speed.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS WILLIAM T. WALTERS, Reg. No. 25880-048, was convicted in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York on an indictment (Docket No. S1 16 CR 00338-02 (PKC)) to violations of Sections 78(j)(b) and 78ff, Title 15, Sections 371, 981(a)(1)(C), 1343, and 1349, Title 18, and Section 2461, Title 28, United States Code, for which a total sentence of 60 months' imprisonment, one year's supervised release, a \$10,000,000 fine, restitution of \$8,882,022.80 (as ordered on October 20, 2017, and amended on October 5, 2020), forfeiture of \$25,352,490.00 (as ordered on September 20, 2017) and a special assessment of \$1,000.00 was imposed on July 27, 2017; and

WHEREAS the said **WILLIAM T. WALTERS** had been confined continuously since he surrendered to federal custody on October 10, 2017, until he was released to serve the remainder of his sentence on home confinement on May 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that the ends of justice do not require the said **WILLIAM T. WALTERS** to remain on confinement until his currently projected release date of January 10, 2022, and the safety of the community will not be compromised if he is released;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that I, **DONALD J. TRUMP**, President of the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, divers other good and sufficient reasons me thereunto moving, do hereby grant clemency to the said **WILLIAM T. WALTERS**: I commute the 60-month prison sentence imposed upon the said **WILLIAM T. WALTERS** to time served. I leave intact and in effect the remaining one-year term of supervised release with all its conditions, the unpaid balances, if any, of his fine, restitution, forfeiture, and special assessment obligations, and all other components of the sentence.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower, the Office of the Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to deliver to the Bureau of Prisons, to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, and to the said **WILLIAM T. WALTERS** a certified copy of this document as evidence of my action in order to carry into effect the terms of this grant.

WHEREAS **KWAME MALIK KILPATRICK**, Reg. No. 44678-039, was convicted, in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan on a superseding indictment (Docket No. 10CR20403-1) of violations of Sections 666(a), 666(a)(B)(2), 1341, 1343, 1951, 1951(b)(2), 1962(d), and 1963(a), Title 18 and Sections 7201(1) and 7206(1), Title 26, United States Code, for which a total sentence of 336 months' imprisonment, three years' supervised release, \$4,779,826.61 restitution, and a \$2,400 special assessment was imposed on October 10, 2013; and

WHEREAS the said **KWAME MALIK KILPATRICK** has been confined continuously since the jury sitting in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan returned verdict on March 11, 2013, and is presently incarcerated at the Federal Correctional Institution – Oakdale I in Oakdale, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS it has been made to appear that the ends of justice do not require the said **KWAME MALIK KILPATRICK** to remain confined until his currently projected release date of January 18, 2037, and the safety of the community will not be compromised if he is released;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT KNOWN that I, **DONALD J. TRUMP**, President of the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, divers other good and sufficient reasons me thereunto moving, do hereby grant clemency to the said **KWAME MALIK KILPATRICK**: I commute the prison sentence imposed upon the said **KWAME MALIK KILPATRICK** to time served. I leave intact and in effect the remaining unpaid balance of the \$4,779,826.61 restitution obligation, the special assessment of \$2,400, the three-year term of supervised release with all its conditions, and all other components of the sentence.



WHEREAS **JON MICHAEL HARDER**, Reg. No. 74589-065, was convicted, in the United States District Court for the District of Oregon on an amended indictment (Docket No. 3:12-CR-00485-SI) of violations of Sections 2, 981(a)(1)(C), 1341, and 1957, Title 18, and Section 2461, Title 28, United States Code, for which a total sentence of 180 months' imprisonment, three years' supervised release, forfeiture of approximately \$115,810 and additional property (by orders of July 1, 2015 and August 31, 2015), and a \$200 special assessment was imposed on November 17, 2015, as amended December 2, 2015; and

WHEREAS the said **JON MICHAEL HARDER** has been confined continuously since he surrendered to the custody of the Bureau of Prisons on February 25, 2016, and is presently incarcerated at the Federal Correctional Institution – Sheridan in Sheridan, Oregon; and
