
COUNT ONE


*False Statements Relating to Health Care Matters*  
18 U.S.C. § 1035 and 18 U.S.C. § 2

Beginning not later than August 2013 and continuing until on or about December 2013, in the Southern District of Georgia and elsewhere, the defendant, **CHRISTOPHER DUBOIS**, did knowingly and willfully make materially false statements and representations, that is, he created false prescriptions, in connection with the delivery of and payment for health care benefits, items, and services involving the Federal Employee Health Benefits Plan, a health care benefit program as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 24(b).

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1035.
