INDICTMENT

21 U.S.C. § 843(a)(3)
18 U.S.C. § 922(g)(3) and 924(a)(2)

The Grand Jury Charges:

COUNT I

From on or about March, 2014, to on or about January, 2018, in the District of Nebraska, the defendant, JEFFREY FRASER, knowingly and intentionally obtained Hydrocodone and Oxycodone, Schedule III and Schedule II controlled substances respectively, by misrepresentation, fraud, forgery, deception, or subterfuge, to wit: involving patients and employees to obtain prescriptions for his personal use.

In violation of Title 21, United States Code, Section 843(a)(3).

COUNT II


On or about January 2, 2018, in the District of Nebraska, defendant, JEFFREY FRASER, then being addicted to a controlled substance as defined in 21 U.S.C. § 802, to wit, Hydrocodone and Oxycodone, Schedule III and Schedule II controlled substances respectively, did knowingly possess in and affecting commerce, a Smith and Wesson .38 Special +P caliber model 638-3 Airweight 5-shot revolver, which had been shipped and transported in interstate commerce.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(3) and 924(a)(2).
