INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

General Allegations

At all times relevant to this indictment:

1. Athol Savings Bank was a financial institution whose deposits were federally-

insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

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2. Defendant Jessica Vargas ("VARGAS") was a resident of Athol, Massachusetts and an employee of Athol Savings Bank. VARGAS began working as a teller at Athol Savings Bank and was promoted to Branch Supervisor in or around May 2017.

3. Athol Savings Bank requires that customers fill out and sign a withdrawal slip in order to make a cash withdrawal from a bank teller.

4. Customer 1 was an 88-year-old female who resided in Athol, Massachusetts and was a customer of Athol Savings Bank.

5. Customer 2 was an 84-year-old female who resided in Athol, Massachusetts and was a customer of Athol Savings Bank.

Scheme to Defraud

6. VARGAS utilized the Athol Savings Bank computer system to access customer accounts without the knowledge or permission of the pertinent bank customers.

7. VARGAS processed certain unauthorized transfers between Athol Savings Bank customer accounts.

8. Between in or about August 2016 through in or about December 2017, VARGAS processed unauthorized cash withdrawals totaling approximately \$108,000 from certain Athol Savings Bank customer accounts, including the following:

- Approximately \$13,000 in unauthorized cash withdrawals from accounts held by Customer 1, including a withdrawal of \$1,950 on or about October 16, 2017 and a withdrawal of 2,000 on or about December 7, 2017; and
- b. Approximately \$53,000 in unauthorized cash withdrawals from an account held by Customer 2 and her husband, including a withdrawal of \$3,025 on or about October 5, 2017.

COUNT ONE: (18 U.S.C. § 1344 – Bank Fraud)

The Grand Jury further charges that:

9. Paragraphs 1 through 8 are re-alleged and incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein

10. On or about December 7, 2017, at Athol, in the District of Massachusetts, and elsewhere,

JESSICA VARGAS,

defendant herein, did knowingly execute a scheme and artifice to defraud a financial institution and to obtain, by means of materially false and fraudulent pretenses, representations and promises, moneys, funds, assets and other property owned by and under the custody and control of a financial institution, to wit: Athol Savings Bank, by processing an unauthorized withdrawal of funds from an Athol Savings Bank customer account in the amount of \$2,000.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1344.

COUNT TWO: (18 U.S.C. § 656 – Bank Embezzlement)

The Grand Jury further charges that:

11. On or about October 5, 2017, at Athol, in the District of Massachusetts,

JESSICA VARGAS,

defendant herein, being an agent and employee of Athol Savings Bank, a federally-insured bank, with intent to injure and defraud, willfully misapplied, embezzled, and purloined the sum of approximately \$3,025 of the funds of Athol Savings Bank and of funds intrusted to the custody and care of Athol Savings Bank, in that the defendant processed an unauthorized withdrawal of funds from an Athol Savings Bank customer account.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 656.

COUNT THREE: (18 U.S.C. § 656 – Bank Embezzlement)

The Grand Jury further charges that:

12. On or about October 16, 2017, at Athol, in the District of Massachusetts,

JESSICA VARGAS,

defendant herein, being an agent and employee of Athol Savings Bank, a federally-insured bank, with intent to injure and defraud, willfully misapplied, embezzled, and purloined the sum of approximately \$1,950 of the funds of Athol Savings Bank and of funds intrusted to the custody and care of Athol Savings Bank, in that the defendant processed an unauthorized withdrawal of funds from an Athol Savings Bank customer account.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 656.

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION (18 U.S.C. § 982(a)(2)(A))

13. Upon conviction of one or more of the offenses in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1344, as set forth in Count One of this Indictment, and Title 18, United States Code, Section 656, set forth in Counts Two and Three of this Indictment,

JESSICA VARGAS,

defendant herein, shall forfeit to the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(2)(A), any property constituting, or derived from, proceeds obtained directly or indirectly, as a result of such offenses. The property to be forfeited includes, but is not limited to, the following:

a. \$108,171, to be entered in the form of a forfeiture money judgment;

14. If any of the property described in Paragraph 13, above, as being forfeitable pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(1), as a result of any act or omission of the defendant –

- (a) cannot be located upon the exercise of due diligence;
- (b) has been transferred or sold to, or deposited with, a third party;
- (c) has been placed beyond the jurisdiction of the Court;
- (d) has been substantially diminished in value; or
- (e) has been commingled with other property which cannot be divided without difficulty;

it is the intention of the United States, pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(b), incorporating Title 21, United States Code, Section 853(p), to seek forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of the property described in Paragraph 13 above.

All pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 982(a)(2).
