The Grand Jury Charges charges that:

COUNT 1

On or about June 26, 2010, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR. did knowingly take, with the intent to barter, without being permitted to do so, migratory birds, to wit: four (4) yellow-crowned night herons (*Nyctanssa violacea*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(b)(1).

COUNT 2

On or about October 25, 2011, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR. did knowingly sell, without being permitted to do so, migratory birds, to wit: fourteen (14) white ibis (*Eudocimus albus*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(b)(2).

COUNT 3

On or about November 8, 2011, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, **ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR.** did knowingly sell, without being permitted to do so, a migratory birds, to wit: five (5) white ibis (*Eudocimus albus*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C §§ 703 & 707(b)(2).

COUNT 4

On or about November 20, 2011, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, **ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR.** did knowingly sell, without being permitted to do so, migratory birds, to wit; twelve (12) white ibis (*Eudocimus albus*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(b)(2).

COUNT 5

On or about November 25, 2011, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, **ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR**. did knowingly sell, without being permitted to do so, migratory birds, to wit; twenty-one (21) white ibis (*Eudocimus albus*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(b)(2).

COUNT 6

On or about December 14, 2011, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, **ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR.** did knowingly sell, without being permitted to do so, migratory birds, to wit; ten (10) white ibis (*Eudocimus albus*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(b)(2).

COUNT 7

On or about April 2, 2012, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR., did possess without being permitted to do so, a migratory bird, to wit; one (1) Barn Owl (*Tyto alba*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(a), and Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 21.11.

COUNT 8

On or about April 2, 2012, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, ROYLEY A. FOLSE, JR., did possess without being permitted to do so, a migratory bird, to wit; (1) Red-Tailed Hawk (*Buteo jamaicensis*), a federally protected bird species under the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all in violation of 16 U.S.C. §§ 703 & 707(a), and Title 50, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 21.11.
