did knowingly possess material that contained at least three images of child pornography, as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8), which images were mailed, shipped, and transported using any means or facility of interstate and foreign commerce and in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, and that were produced using materials that were mailed, shipped, and transported in and affecting interstate and foreign commerce by any means, including by computer, after having sustained a prior conviction in the State of New Jersey and a prior conviction in the State of Delaware, each relating to aggravated sexual abuse, sexual abuse, or abusive sexual contact involving a minor or ward.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2252A(a)(5)(B) and (b)(2).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

1. The allegations contained in page one of this Information are hereby realleged and incorporated by reference for the purpose of alleging forfeiture pursuant to Title 18, United States Code, Section 2253(a).

Upon conviction for violating Title 18, United States Code, Sections
2252A(a)(5)(B) and (b)(2), defendant

JEFFREY SPICER

shall forfeit to the United States any and all matter that contains visual depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct in violation of the charged offenses; any property constituting or derived from any proceeds the defendant obtained directly or indirectly as a result of the said violations; and any and all property used or intended to be used in any manner or part to commit and to promote the commission of the aforementioned violations or any property traceable to such property, including but not limited to the following:

- a. Samsung Galaxy SIII cellular telephone bearing serial number R31D41K6S2X,
- b. Adaptec External Hard drive bearing serial number 050051705,
- c. Seagate Barracuda 250GB hard drive bearing serial number 3ND145HV, and
- d. SanDisk Cruzer 4GB flash drive bearing serial number BH0709JTKB.
