

Attachment B: FEA BRMv3 Service Mappings and Agency IT Portfolio Summary Part Mapping

Overview

The following guidance has been developed to help Investment Management (ITIM) coordinators understand the new Federal Enterprise Architecture (FEA) Business Reference Model (BRM) v3 Service mappings in the IT Investment Summary.

The guidance includes two sections:

- B1. FEA BRMv3 Service Mappings
- B2. Agency IT Portfolio Summary Part Mapping

B1. FEA BRMv3 Service Mappings

OMB released an update to the BRMv3.1. These updates are intended to help agencies more accurately define and align their investments to the business functions. The BRMv3.1 allows for multiple mappings between IT investments and the BRMv3 services that they provide. The primary business service field is mapped to the business purpose of the investment. This field also helps to determine the part of the Agency IT Portfolio Summary an IT investment should be placed. The secondary BRM service field provides additional information on the investment. Use of BRM mappings beyond primary and secondary services is used sparingly.

The DOJ Enterprise Architecture Program Management Office (EAPMO) has reviewed all of the investments in the Agency IT Investment Summary and provided primary and secondary mappings for each. This information is pre-populated in eCPIC for components to review. ITIM Coordinators are asked to validate their investments to the primary service (primary BRMv3.1 field) and secondary service mapping, if applicable.

Changing BRM Mappings for an IT Investment

The DOJ EAPMO has reviewed the updated FEA BRMv3.1 against the DOJ business model. **Table 1: Mapping Rules** provides some of the general guidelines/rules developed by the DOJ EAPMO when remapping all IT investments to the FEA BRMv3. Please contact the DOJ EAPMO with any specific questions on the primary and secondary mapping of an IT Investment that you have.

If a component would like to change the BRMv3 service mapping provided, they must email the eCPIC Help Desk Group (eCPICHelpDOJ@usdoj.gov) indicating the mapping change. When changing the BRMv3 service mapping, ITIM coordinators must also update the IT investment description. This description must clearly show how the IT investment relates to the new primary BRMv3 service.

Agency IT Portfolio Summary Part Mapping

After assigning the BRMv3 service code, the Department will place the IT investment in the correct part (or section) of the Agency IT Portfolio Summary. Each of the BRMv3 services have been aligned to a specific Agency IT Portfolio Summary Part, allowing the primary business service to determine how the IT Investment is reported to OMB. OMB defines the parts as:

- Part 1: IT Investments for Mission Delivery Areas and Management Support Areas
- Part 2: IT Investments for Infrastructure, IT Security, Office Automation, and Telecommunications
- Part 3: IT Investments for EA, Capital Planning, and CIO Functions
- Part 4: IT Investments for Grants Management Systems
- Part 5: National Security Systems IT Investments
- Part 6: Grants to State and Local IT Investments

Additional descriptions of the parts can be found in OMB Circular A-11, Section 55 Guidance. DOJ only uses Parts 1-4 the remaining parts do not apply to DOJ.

Note: The correct Agency IT Portfolio Summary Part placement is important for IT investments that support *common* IT infrastructure needs, versus those IT investments that support *mission* needs but contain embedded IT Infrastructure. Mapping to the *Primary BRMv3 Service* will determine the correct Agency IT Portfolio Summary Part placement for IT Infrastructure investments.
