Change in Department of Justice's (DOJ) Career Transition

Assistance Plan (CTAP)

In accordance with 5 CFR 330.606, DOJ Components are required to consider surplus and displaced DOJ employees for competitive service vacancies before screening the applications of other candidates for positions within the Department of Justice.

To expedite the DOJ's CTAP clearance process, DOJ Components may clear the Department's CTAP list for surplus and displaced DOJ employees by contacting designated DOJ CTAP Coordinators (list attached). This guidance supersedes previous Departmental guidance and Justice Management Division Human Resources is incorporating this change in future updated Departmental CTAP policy.

DOJ Components may now choose to either post vacancy announcements open only to surplus and displaced employees with a minimum open period of five working days, per DOJ's CTAP guidance dated July 3, 2001, or they may contact each of the Department's designated CTAP Coordinators and provide documentation of reply in the case file. Vacancy announcements must contain information on how eligible employees can apply, what proof of eligibility is required, and the criteria for meeting the definition of well-qualified.
