INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT ONE

(Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine)

On or about May 26, 2022, in Ohio County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, defendant **CHRISTOPHER LOUIS PARK**, did unlawfully, knowingly, intentionally, and without authority, possess with the intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine, also known as “coke,” a Schedule II controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

COUNT TWO

(Possession with Intent to Distribute Cocaine Base)

On or about May 26, 2022, in Ohio County, in the Northern District of West Virginia, defendant **CHRISTOPHER LOUIS PARK**, did unlawfully, knowingly, intentionally, and without authority, possess with the intent to distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of cocaine base, also known as “crack,” a Schedule II controlled substance; in violation of Title 21, United States Code, Sections 841(a)(1) and 841(b)(1)(C).

FORFEITURE ALLEGATION

Controlled Substance Act

Pursuant to Title 21, United States Code, Section 853 and Title 21, United States Code, Section 841, the government will seek the forfeiture of property as part of the sentence imposed in this case; that is, the forfeiture of any property used, or intended to be used, to commit or to facilitate the commission of the above referenced offense, and any property constituting, or derived from, proceeds obtained directly or indirectly, as a result of such offense, including, but not limited to \$4,823 in United States currency seized during a residential search warrant on May 26, 2022.
