FACTUAL BASIS

Should this matter have gone to trial, the government would have proved, through the introduction of competent testimony and admissible tangible evidence, the following to support the allegations charged by the government in the one-count Bill of Information now pending against the defendant, JOSHUA ADAMS (hereafter "ADAMS").

Special Agents from the United States Postal Service Office of Inspector General ("OIG") would testify that on December 31, 2020, they received information that a U.S. Postal Express Mail Package was stolen from the North Kenner Station, Louisiana Post Office located in Kenner, Louisiana, located in the Eastern District of Louisiana. The package was addressed to individual "A" in Covington, Louisiana 70435. The package, though addressed to Covington, Louisiana 70435, was in the North Kenner Station for transport to Covington. The package was placed in a steel cage enclosure for safekeeping at the at the Kenner Location.

ADAMS was videotaped by security cameras at the Kenner Station stealing and secreting the package under his tee shirt after removing the package without permission from the security cage. Video camera footage further showed ADAMS leaving the postal facility to the parking lot where his vehicle was parked.



Postal OIG employees would further testify that the Express Mail Package was in the mail in the North Kenner Station and that **ADAMS** stole the Express Mail Package to deprive the sender of the package.
