INDICTMENT

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

Introduction

At all times material to this Indictment:

- 1. **DARREL R. RINEHART** was an internist who was licensed by the State of Tennessee Department of Health, Board of Examiners as a medical doctor under license number 15431 on August 17, 1984.
- 2. As part of his practice, **DARREL R. RINEHART** prescribed controlled substances, including highly addictive opioids, with his Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) license under DEA License Number AR1715068.
- 3. Under the Controlled Substances Act, Title 21, United States Code, Section 841(a) et seq., and Title 21, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1306.04, a prescription for a controlled substance is not legal or effective unless issued for a legitimate medical purpose by a practitioner acting in the usual course of professional practice.
- 4. **DARREL R. RINEHART** routinely prescribed various Schedule II controlled substances, including morphine sulfate, hydrocodone, oxycodone, and dextroamphetamine for his patients outside the usual course of professional practice and without a legitimate medical purpose.

- 5. Patients A, B, C and D, who were actively being seen as patients by **DARREL R. RINEHART**, passed away.
- 6. On or about November 27, 2018, the Tennessee Board of Medical Examiners suspended **DARREL R. RINEHART's** Tennessee medical license until May 31, 2019, at which time his Tennessee license would expire. **DARREL R. RINEHART** was also prohibited from renewing his Tennessee license or applying for a new license in Tennessee.

COUNTS 1 through 19

- 7. Paragraphs 1 through 6 are re-alleged and incorporated by reference as though fully set forth herein.
- 8. On or about the dates set forth in each count below, in the Middle District of Tennessee,

DARREL R. RINEHART

did knowingly, intentionally, and without authority, distribute a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of morphine sulfate, oxycodone, hydrocodone, and dextroamphetamine, all Schedule II controlled substances, as listed below, without a legitimate medical purpose and outside the usual course of professional practice, each of which constitutes a separate count of this Indictment:
