TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

BE IT KNOWN, THAT THIS DAY, I, DONALD J. TRUMP, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, PURSUANT TO MY POWERS UNDER ARTICLE II, SECTION 2, CLAUSE 1, OF THE CONSTITUTION, HAVE GRANTED UNTO

DAVID HOSSEIN SAFAVIAN

A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON

FOR HIS CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, on a superseding indictment following a vacated conviction (Docket No. 05-370-PLF), charging violation of Sections 1001(a)(1), 1001(a)(2), and 1505, Title 18, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on October 16, 2009, to a term of 12 months and one day's imprisonment and 24 months' supervised release.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower the Office of the Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to sign a grant of clemency to the person named herein. The Office of the Pardon Attorney shall declare that its action is the act of the President, being performed at my direction.
