A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON


FOR HIS CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas on an indictment (Docket No. DR-02-CR-526(1) WWJ) charging violation of Section 242, Title 18, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on March 10, 2003, to 27 months' imprisonment, two years' supervised release, and a \$100 special assessment.

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower the Acting Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to sign a grant of clemency to the person named herein. The Acting Pardon Attorney shall declare that her action is the act of the President, being performed at my direction.
