

Executive Grant of Clemency

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

BE IT KNOWN, THAT THIS DAY, I, DONALD J. TRUMP, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, PURSUANT TO MY POWERS UNDER ARTICLE II, SECTION 2, CLAUSE 1, OF THE CONSTITUTION, HAVE GRANTED UNTO

FREDERICK JOHN NAHAS

A FULL AND UNCONDITIONAL PARDON

FOR HIS CONVICTION in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey on an information (Docket No. 3:02-CR-0459) charging violation of Section 1518, Title 18, United States Code, for which he was sentenced on January 2, 2003, to one month's imprisonment, three years' supervised release, conditioned upon two months' residence in a residential reentry facility, three months' home confinement, and 100 hours' community service, a \$20,000 fine, and a \$100 special assessment (as amended on January 21, 2003).

I HEREBY DESIGNATE, direct, and empower the Acting Pardon Attorney, as my representative, to sign a grant of clemency to the person named herein. The Acting Pardon Attorney shall declare that her action is the act of the President, being performed at my direction.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto caused this Pardon to be recorded with the Department of Justice.
