

2128, 2129. United States v. Combustion Engineering, Inc., Civil Action Nos. 13998, 13999 (DC Conn.) (Sec. 7, Clayton Act, acquisitions of Wickes Corp. boiler division and assets of Bauer Bros. Co.): On September 8, 1971, a consent decree requiring Combustion Engineering, Inc., to divest all INDUSTRIAL BOILER manufacturing assets acquired from the Wickes Corporation became final (CCH 1971 TRADE CASES ¶ 73,648).

On December 19, 1972, the government's motion in Case No. 2128 for further relief under the decree was denied (CCH 1973 TRADE CASES ¶ 74,328).

On January 1, 1974 the complaint, Case No. 2129, challenging the acquisition of Bauer Bros. Co. was dismissed without prejudice pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
