COUNT 1

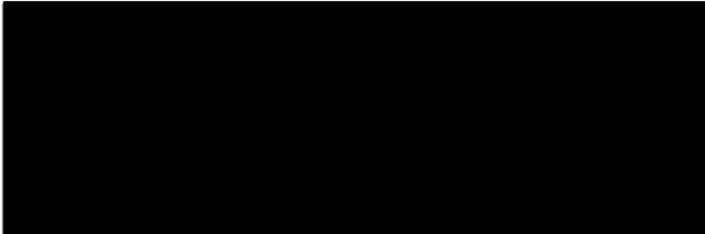
On or about August 3, 2022, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, the defendant, **MARIO HERNANDEZ-MARIN**, a/k/a "Jose Hernandez-Marin", a/k/a "David Hernandez-Marin", a/k/a "Jose G. Hernandez", a/k/a "Daniel Enrique-Polanco", a/k/a "David Hernandez-Enrique", was found in the United States after having been officially deported and removed therefrom on or about June 23, 2011, and without the approval of the Attorney General of the United States or his designated successor, the Secretary of the Department of Homeland

Security, as provided for in Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), 202(4), and 557, having expressly consented to the defendant's reapplication for admission into the United States, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a).

NOTICE OF SENTENCING ENHANCEMENT

Now comes the United States of America, by and through Duane A. Evans, the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Louisiana, to give notice that on or about July 10, 2008, in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Louisiana, the defendant, **MARIO HERNANDEZ-MARIN**, was convicted under case number 07-20094-001 of re-entry of a removed alien, in violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), as well as murder, an aggravated felony, in the 103rd District Court of Cameron County Texas on September 29, 1995. Because of these felony convictions, if the defendant is convicted of a violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a), the defendant's sentence will be subject to a maximum sentence of imprisonment of not more than 20 years, pursuant to Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(b)(2).
